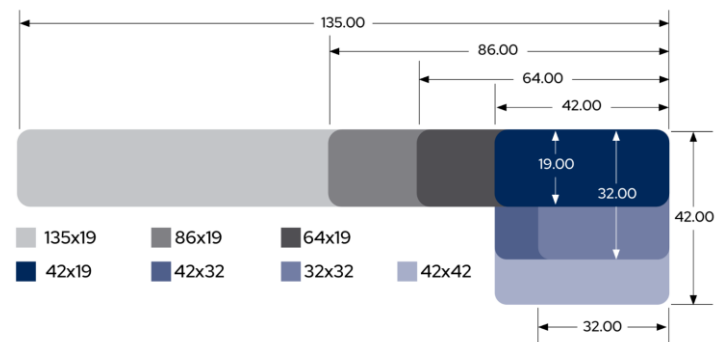
Flooring (Overlay)
